

## Dress Code

---

### Students CAN wear:

- Collard shirts, polo necks and blouses
- Jumpers and cardigans
- Blazers or smart jackets
- Smart trousers
- Dark coloured jeans (navy, black, dark grey), without rips or holes
- Smart skirts or dresses (appropriate length)
- Religious dress
- Smart shoes e.g. bogues or loafers
- Smart, clean trainers in neutral colours (black, white or navy)
- Jewellery
- Appropriate make-up (not too excessive)

### Students CANNOT wear:

- Light blue or ripped jeans
- T-shirts with slogans or large logos
- Hoodies
- Sportswear (including tracksuit bottoms or football shirts)
- Crocs, sliders or flipflops
- Ugg boots
- Brightly coloured trainers
- Revealing clothing (crop tops, low-waist trousers, short length skirts/dresses etc.)

**If you can't imagine your teachers wearing it, then neither should you!**

Failure to attend school in clothing that adheres to the dress code will result in a sanction. You will also be given appropriate clothing to wear from the **Sixth Form uniform cupboard**. In certain instances, you may be sent home to change into appropriate attire.
